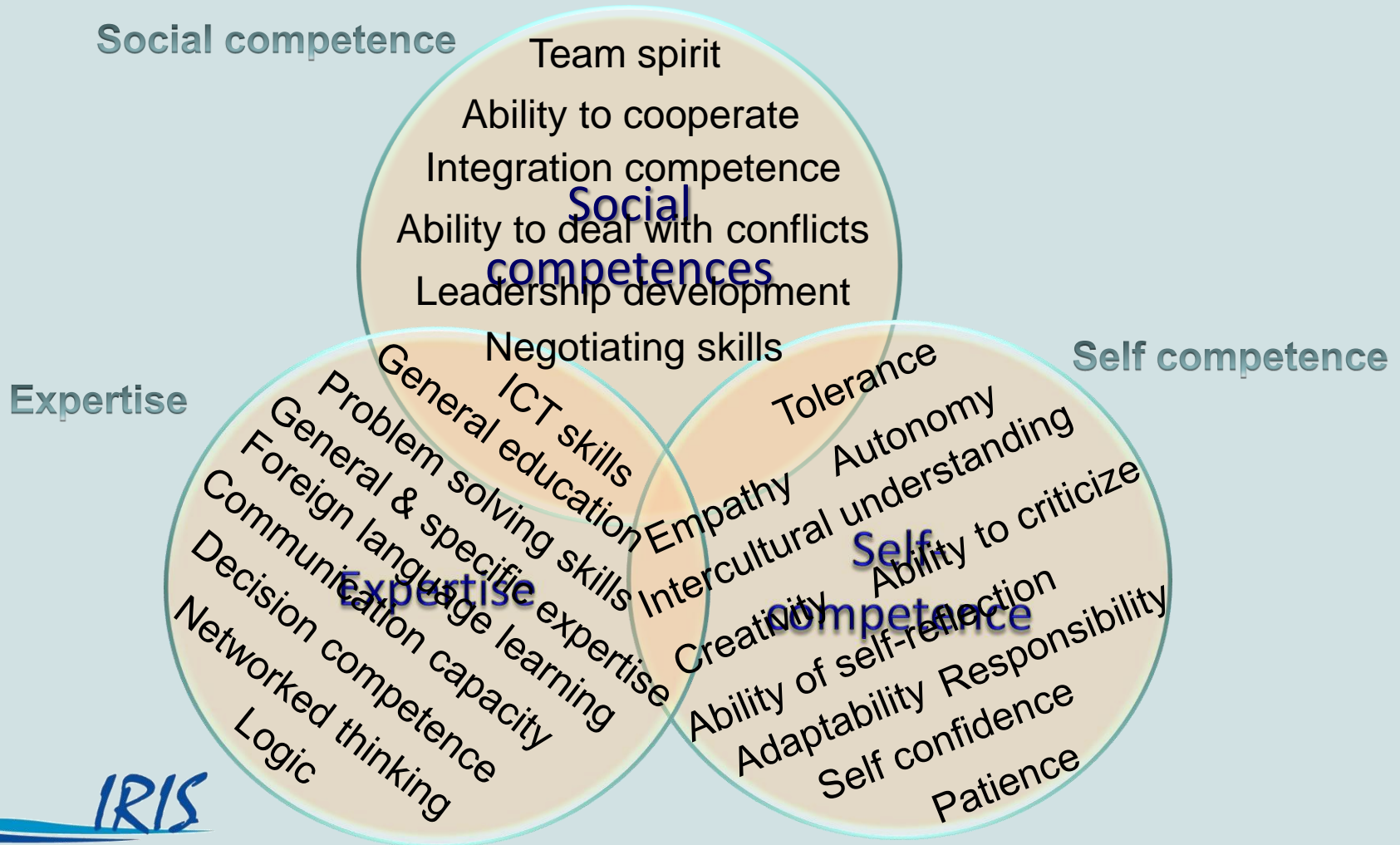

Incoming Students

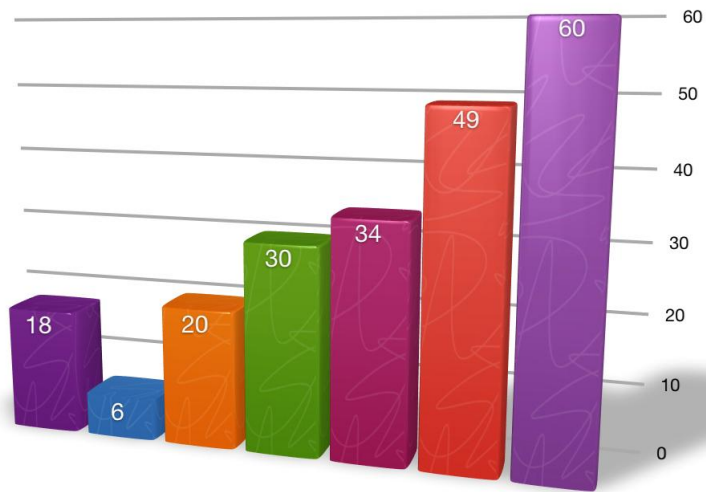


Outgoing Students



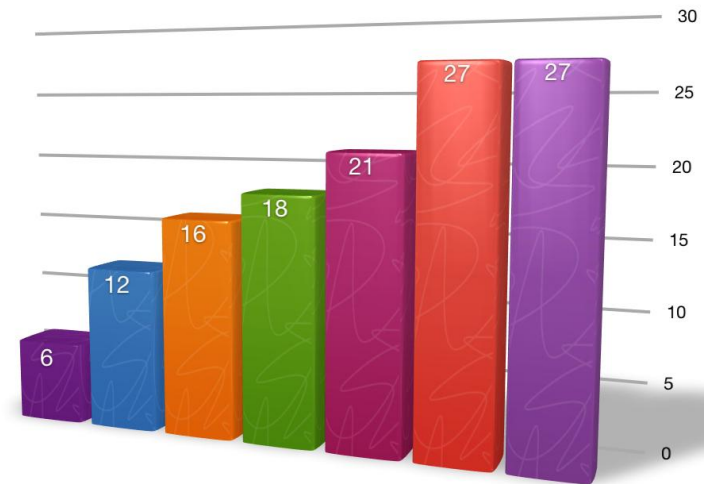

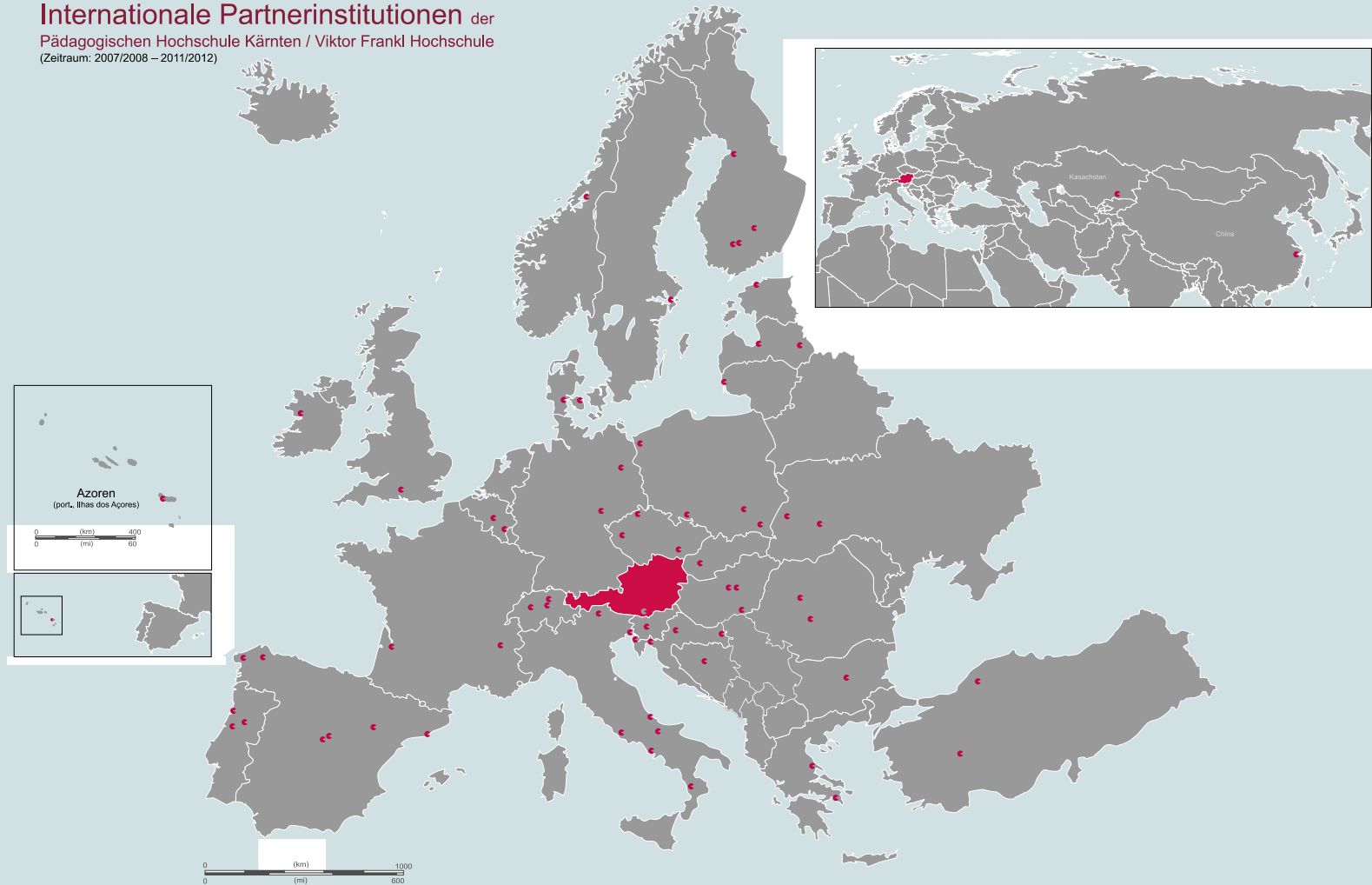
